

















About the Inter Act Art

Having established in 1992, the IAA is a multi-ethnic, multi-lingual, multi-religious institution, involved in development of theatre and performing art. During its existence of nearly two and half decades, IAA has completed many useful activities for the theatre and theatre fraternity.

IAA team members were the pioneers in introducing Forum Theatre (Sinhala and Tamil) and Black Box Theatre to Sri Lanka, as a different dimension in theatre art. Modern Monodrama Concept Aligning with the main objective, IAA has trained island-wide and internationally young creators, undergraduates and corporate sector personnel, in modern trends and techniques.

IAA located at Sri Jayawardenepura, the Administrative Capital, of Sri Lanka and is the second in South East Asia.

IAA takes pride being the owner of one and only International Theatre Festival - The Colombo International Theatre Festival – an annual event commenced in 2012, which became a turning point in National Theatre arena. IAA has a mini-theatre house, a Theatre Academy, a Training Centre for Private Sector Employees, a Dancing Section, a Drama Production Unit, Film and Television Production Unit and a Publication Section.

IAA organizes two alternative National Theatre Festivals and two International Theatre Festivals annually:

- a) Sri Lankan theatre festival
- b) Black Box short play festival
- c) Colombo International Theatre Festival (CITF)
- d) Colombo Mono Drama Festival

Albeit being a small organization it has built a considerable relationship with the international artists/institutions through its activities.

M. Safeer - Founder/CEO

An award winning director of theatre, a playwright, the pioneer who introduced concepts of Black Box Theatre and Forum theatre in addition to few other forms of theatre to Sri Lanka, a director of a publishing house which has published numerous books during the past three decades, founder of the Colombo International Theatre Festival, an annual event since 2012.

He has directed more than 50 theatre productions including 5 International Theatre productions, mono dramas, dance and contemporary productions in last three decades.

Safeer has been a participant at numerous National and International theatrical and artistic projects as an invitee as well as a panel member. Along with theatre productions, writing books he has conducted many theatre workshops with different communities, locally and internationally.

As an author he wrote and edited 16 books consecutively with his artistic journey. Among these books Page Maker, Stage Management Hand book, Black Box Theatre (BBT), and Confusious, Tao edited to Sinhala, basic global theatre history and contemporary theatre concept etc.

He has taken his experience too feature "Hereafter Bygone" which is his first cinematic expression created for the film industry with a long lived Dream coming to reality in 2022.

He worked as a consultant and director programmer in numerous international organizations. In 2013 he was invited by FLAME University of Pune (Foundation for Liberal Arts and Management Education) in India for a workshop on physical theatre with the students. At the end of the seminar a play created by him was shown to the participants/ students.

In 2015 he produced and directed three non-verbal monologues with artists from Goa, India after being invited by the Director of Culture and Art of the State of Goa, in India.

Also in 2023 he has been invited by Bhullung-Bhuthur International Theatre Festival, Assam - India to conduct one week long workshop on advance physical theatre.

He is a member of the Executive Committee of National Federation of Theatre Artists in Sri Lanka (NFTAS).

Sujeewa Pathinisekara - Chairman

Sujeewa Pathinisekara, works for the Government of Sri Lanka, studied at Royal College, Colombo, St. Joseph Vaz College, Wennappuwa and Aquinas College, Colombo,



graduated from University of Sri Jayewardenepura in 1993, Master of Arts- Drama & Theatre from University Sri Jayewardenepura in 2008. worked for the drama group "Shakespeare Centre Sri Lanka" and studied acting and theatre from 1994-2011, He translated, directed and produced William Shakespeare's "King Lear" in Sinhala in 2012 it was the first time in the history of Sri Lanka that King Lear has been produced in Sinhala -native language of Sri Lanka.

He has been working with the Inter Act Art team since then. He also directed and acted in the German contemporary play "Violin, Cello, Double Base" in Sinhala

"Api Narakai Thamai" in 2016. Acted in the children's theatre play "Kevin" directed by M. Safeer in 2019. "Untouched" is a contemporary play written and directed by him for the world theatre and won the best performance at Sharm El sheikh International theatre festival for youth 2021 in Egypt. He is the light designer for "Love and Lockdown" theatre production.

Mohamed Shafraz - Secretary

He is professionally a Journalist worked at two major Television stations Swarnavahini and Sirasa tv in Sri lanka as an Executive Director for more than 15 years well experienced in live programmes, Features and Documentaries. professionally he was attached to Tele drama and Visual directing for more than two decades. Vaudhaa (first ever daily soap in Sri Lanka), Kaavyaa, Pathini, Aadare Ahasa tharam were few teles he has directed. He was a dubbing artist, voice caster, script writer too. He has directed two feature films as well.

Basically he translated few books since 2002 itself. Sensouous body, Successful Speaker, Acting for camera, Beloved Shaliha (Sufi philosophy), Chinese language studies through Ecstatic kungfu /12books, Belt and the Road Initiative, Expats in China and The Forbidden City.

He is the secretary to the Colombo International theatre Festival and been the stage manager in "Untouched" written and directed by Sujeewa Pathinisekara and "Love and Lockdown" directed by M.safeer. He is a full-time member of Inter Act Art Theatre at present.





Prasad Wickramaratne Executive Committee Member

After completing the primary education at Dambadeniya Maha Vidyalaya named after the ancient city he continued his Secondary Education at Royal College, Colombo.

He holds a MSc in Agriculture from Kharkov Agrarian University in Ukraine and a Masters in Customs Administration from Postgraduate Institute of Management (PIM) of Sri Jayawardenepura University. Presently Prasad Wickramaratne works for Sri Lanka Customs as a Senir Deputy Director.

He had been a casual actor in experimental short films. He comes out of the self-imposed exile to write the drama script "Love and Lockdown" on M. Safeer's request.

Subuddhi Lakmali is a vocalist, actor & a voice trainer who has been working since 2007. She started her carrier from the theatre & expanded her acting capacity to the silver screen as well as the television. She has been nominated as the best singer, best actor in the State Awards in Sri Lanka.

She acted in Inter Act Art production "Untouched" Monodrama directed by Sujeewa Pathinisekara and won the best performance at Sharm-El Sheikh International Theatre Festival for Youth (SITFY) Egypt in November 2021.
